I hope this letter finds you and your family safe and healthy during this extended Spring "Break", the likes of which we have never experienced before. As you know, Governor Polis issued an Executive Order prohibiting in-person education across the state through April 17<sup>th</sup>. Although we hold out hope that we will return to school (as normal) on Monday, April 20<sup>th</sup>, we have created a remote learning plan that, if necessary, will last the duration of the semester.

While the students' Spring Break was extended a week, know that our staff is currently hard at work preparing for their students' future learning opportunities; no matter how different those might look. In a matter of days, our staff has been forced to take years (and perhaps decades) of lesson plans, classroom routines, schedules, and other "typical" ways of teaching and suddenly revamp everything. Times such as these call for patience and flexibility, for all parties involved.

Remote learning will begin on Monday, March 30<sup>th</sup>. What this will look like depends largely on the age of your child(ren). Please review the supporting documents (Remote Learning Plan and Online Class Schedule), as they provide further details.

# **Idalia's Distance Learning Plan – Spring 2020**

<u>Purpose:</u> In less than ideal times, provide students the resources and opportunity to continue to learn, while preparing them for success at the next grade level in the fall.

<u>Time</u>: Remote Learning will begin on March 30<sup>th</sup>. Elementary (PK-6) teachers will provide packets to keep students engaged for the remainder of the semester (and even into the summer). JH/HS online classes will conclude by May 15<sup>th</sup>.

\*Under the assumption in-person education will not resume this academic year.

# PK-6<sup>th</sup> Grade:

Each teacher will prepare a "packet" of essential curriculum for students to work on at home (with parents) for remainder of academic year.

- The packet will be emailed to parents along with a hard-copy pickup option at the school @ 9am on 3/30.
- There will be no assignments officially submitted or graded by staff (although parents are encouraged to email assignments to teachers for feedback, questions, etc)
  - \*Unsure what final grades will look like this semester still waiting on guidance from CDE in regard to that
- Teachers will be available during "remote office hours" to answer any student/parent questions for a minimum of 4 hours each week. Each elementary teacher will directly reach out to their parents to discuss their office hour schedule and how to best access them during those scheduled hours.
- Teachers will always (Mon-Fri, 8am-3:30pm) be available via email and respond to any questions within 24 hours.

# 7<sup>th</sup>-12 Grade:

Teachers and students will utilize technology (including Microsoft Teams, email, etc) to continue classes.

- "Microsoft Teams" (under the Microsoft 365 umbrella) will be the platform primarily used to carry out the on-line classes
  - Brad and Mindy Richards will hold a virtual training for students on the use of Microsoft Teams on Friday 3/27.
    - \*Students will receive an email on their Idalia issued email address prior to 3/27 with more information about this training
    - \*\*Any interested parents are encouraged to sit in on this training with their child(ren).
- In addition to virtually meeting with their classes, teachers will always (Mon-Fri, 8am-3:30pm) be available via email and respond to any questions within 24 hours.
- PowerSchool will continue to function as the official gradebook.
- Junior High (and a select few High School level) electives will not be offered via the on-line option. For those classes, grades as of 3/13 will be used as semester final grades.
