September 21, 2020

Just hours ago, we received confirmation of a positive COVID-19 test within our Junior High/High School. **Following collaboration with the Northeast Colorado Health Department, it has been decided that our Junior High and High School students (7-12th) will move to remote learning through Monday, September 28th.** Elementary (PK-6th) grade students will continue to operate in regular (GREEN) in-person education. We plan to reconvene regular (GREEN), in-person education for all (PK-12) students on Tuesday, September 29th.

Below is more information:

- All JH/HS extracurricular events (including athletics) have been cancelled for the remainder of the week and may restart on Tuesday 9/29.
- 7 - 12th Grade students, please be reminded that all assignments will be graded during remote learning and you are responsible for keeping up with all class content and assignments.
- The SAT scheduled for 9/23 has been rescheduled for a later date, TBD.
- Younger siblings of JH/HS students are not considered primary contacts and may continue to attend in-person school.
 - **Although the Health Department has determined it is safe for our elementary school to continue with in-person education, anyone not feeling comfortable sending their children to school may choose to keep them home, as has been the case all year.*
- Any JH/HS students in need of food-services for the remainder of the week, please contact Kelly Shaffer (shafferk@idaliaco.us) ASAP.
- Although limited in the information I am able to provide, as determined by NE CO Health, all primary contacts with potential extended exposure to the positive case are amongst 7-12th Grade students/teachers, with the last date of potential contact being on Monday, September 14th. **If it has been determined you are a potential primary contact, you will receive an email from NE CO Health later today with further information, including quarantine directions.*
